

TOTAL SANITATION CAMPAIGN

Implementation of TSC is picking up in the State. So far 12743 nos. of Individual House Hold Latrines (BPL), 11086 nos. of Individual House Hold Latrines (APL), 1069 nos. of School Toilets, 30 nos. of Sanitary Complexes & 106 nos. of Aganwadi Toilets have been constructed up to May 2008. Target/Objective vis-à-vis achievement under TSC is as below :-

As per 2001 Census Data, 40.10% of the total households in Meghalaya have sanitation facilities. Till up to May 2008 with the implementation of TSC, 47.79% of the total households are having Sanitation facilities. It has been estimated that with current growth rate, by 2012 53.28% of the total households would have sanitation facilities. However the programme is picking up and it is expected that about 75% of the rural households could be provided with sanitation facilities by 2012 AD.
