Moreover, she said that though the number of students enrolled in the school increases every year, the same quantity of rice is allotted to the school which adds to the problem created by irregular supply of rice.

SUGGESTION:

The Head Teacher was advised to inform the SDSEO Amlarem about the actual enrollment in the school so as to get the adequate quantity of rice.

OBSERVATION – MID DAY MEAL

During interaction with the Secretary cum head teacher of the school it was learnt that supply of rice and Conversion Cost was not provided at the same time. Very often only rice is available but money for purchase of vegetables was sanctioned very late. Moreover the cook has to bear the responsibility of carrying water for mid day meal which is being provided only two days a week.

SUGGESTIONS:

The school management has to apprise the problem of not getting Conversion Cost along with the supply of rice to the SDSEO Jowai for solution.
